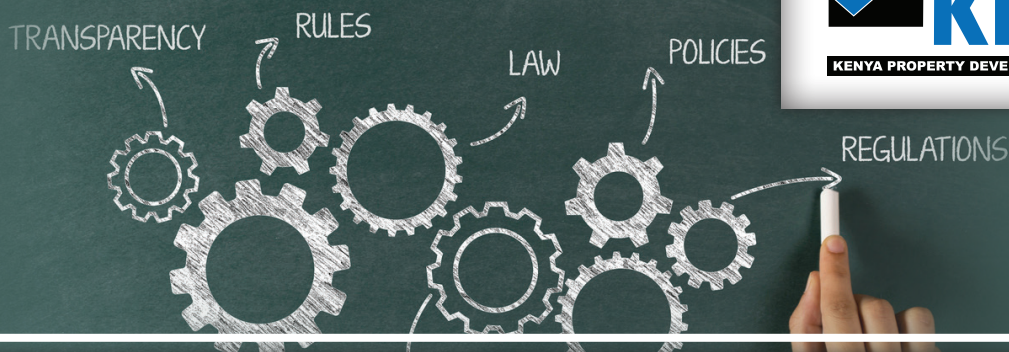

THE MINISTRY OF LANDS AND PHYSICAL PLANNING

The Ministry is headquartered at Ardhi House in Nairobi's Community. Area and it handles all national lands concerns. The Ministry has digitized over 3 million land records and also maintains a library full of the filed paper records for reference. It has records dating back to 1900 with over 100-year-old records are securely stored in both digital and paper records. The Ministry provides the online portal for land owners and buyers to carryout transactions such as search and transfer of ownership amongst other functions.

National Environment Management Authority

THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENT MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY (NEMA)

The National Environment Management Authority (NEMA), is established under the Environmental Management and Co-ordination Act No. 8 of 1999 (EMCA) as the principal instrument of Government for the implementation of all policies relating to environment. EMCA 1999 was enacted against a backdrop of 78 sectoral laws dealing with various components of the environment, the deteriorating state of Kenya’s environment, as well as increasing social and economic inequalities, the combined effect of which negatively impacted on the environment. The supreme objective underlying the enactment of EMCA 1999 was to bring harmony in the management of the country’s environment.



THE WATER REGULATORY AUTHORITY (WRA)

The Water Regulatory Authority is a state corporation established under Section 11 of the Water Act, 2016. It is mandated through delegated Authority on behalf of the National government to safeguard the right to clean water by ensuring that there is proper regulation of the management and use of water resources, in order to ensure sufficient water for everyone—now and in the future. However, the Authority has been in existence for 12 years following its establishment under the Water Act, 2002 as Water Resources Management Authority (WRMA).
